**"Recovery of maintenance in the EU and worldwide"**

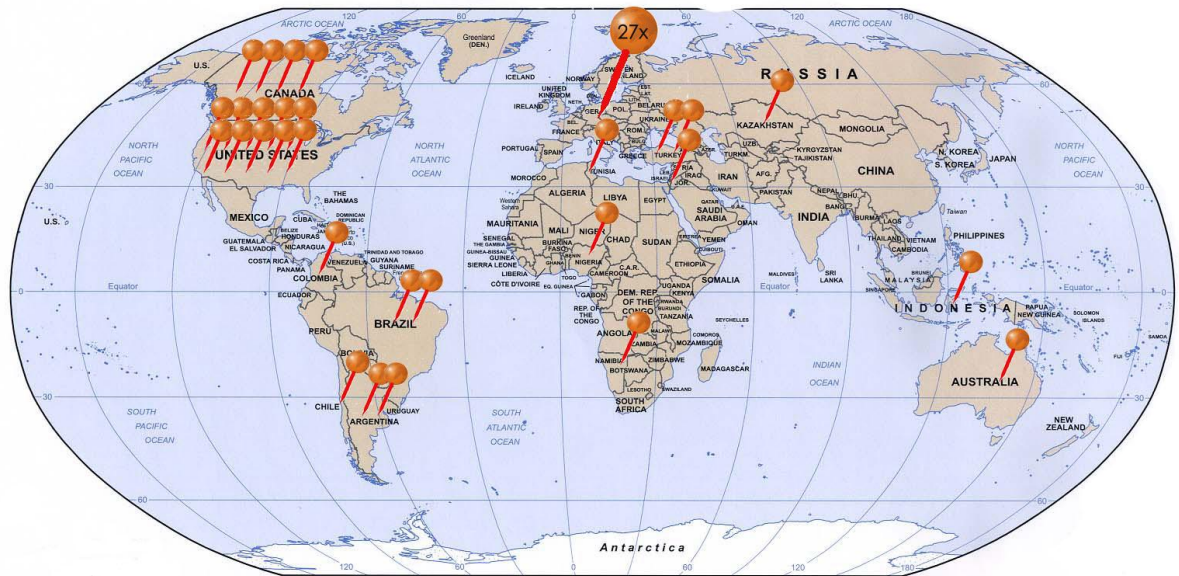
